Results from “The Badger Goss Trophy”, 27 March 2016

A huge thank you to the Devon Classic MCC for putting on a great day of scrambling. The conditions were challenging to say the very least. Those riders who endured all that Mother Nature threw at them showed tremendous resilience and determination and in doing so earned points for their clubs.

Positions after the first event are:

One of the aims of the SW Scramble League is to promote **both** club and AMCA membership.

935 points were earned by riders who had either day licences or not written their AMCA licence number when signing on. As the signing on sheets are used to differentiate AMCA licence holders from day licence holders, these points were not allocated to any clubs.

163 points were earned by riders belonging to clubs outside of the South West. A rider whose licence is registered to a club outside of the SW, but is **also a member of a SW club**, may still earn points for their SW club. They must name that club at signing on and remain with that club for the whole season.

Every finisher score points for their club regardless of class or group.

Classes with smaller entries, such as pre-65 can be big point earners for your club, so get those bikes out of the garage and race them.
